## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

It is my immense pleasure to welcome all the students joining Garhbeta College for pursuing their higher studies during the session 2023-2024. Garhbeta College is one of the oldest colleges in the undivided Midnapore District in the post-independence period. The college was established on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 1948 and we have celebrated the 75<sup>th</sup> years of establishment on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 in a befitting manner. A three day programme was organized on and from 13-15<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 to celebrate the historic moment of our college. The last academic session was very much important to all of us as it was treated as '75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Year' of Garhbeta College which is completed on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2023. A beautiful souvenir was published to commemorate the great occasion. The 'SMARAK BHAVAN' (the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of Ambedkar Bhavan) for the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Garhbeta College is under construction and will be completed very soon and it will be inaugurated after puja vacation. The college building has further been upgraded during this anniversary year especially by making interior decoration of the Seminar Hall with modern appliances and also the renovation & interior decoration of Hall Ghar has been completed recently. Many other recent developments have been initiated like modernization of class rooms (Installation of panel board) and improvement of laboratories considering the modernization of teaching learning process as per upcoming NEP curriculum of Vidyasagar University.

The college is now upgraded as an ideal place of education in a vast area (22 acre approx.) also in a very beautiful location in a close vicinity to 'GANGONI' (the 'Grand Canyon of Bengal') in the bank of river Shilaboti with its own scenic beauty like a 'TOPOBAN'. The greenery of our college is a great beauty that attracts all the visitors. This beauty of the campus alongside the road also catches the eye of every passer-by. It is our dream to promote this institution to be an ideal educational hub of modern times. Different measures have been taken to make our campus plastic free with minimum environmental pollutants. Regular plantation throughout the year has gradually converted our campus as a green campus.

Different effective measures have been initiated by IQAC & NAAC Steering Committee of our college for facing the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle of NAAC assessment during this year with a target to achieve a much better score than the previous one. The present faculty position of our college is very rich and almost all the vacancies have been filled up through recommendation of West Bengal College Service Commission.

A galaxy of eminent teachers has served this institution with their endless efforts to teach their students, many of their former students are in several higher positions in India and abroad. Maintaining the heritage of this institution, the present enriched faculty members of the college have tried their best with its sole objective of providing quality education. The faculty strength is very high at present (more than 100) in the college. Many quality teachers have joined the college through WBCSC in various subjects in the recent past. There is only one full time teaching post lying vacant in Physiology. The nonteaching staff strength in the college is also adequate after recruitment of staff in the permanent vacancies.

The college is now in a position of enjoying greater infrastructural facilities due to renovation and expansion of existing college building. A few proposals for financial grants have been submitted to the State Govt. for construction of class rooms and expansion of new Boys hostel. The proposal for roof top solar panel has also been submitted to state govt. for financial grants. The college is already equipped with various facilities like beautiful football ground, Gymnasium with multi-gym facilities & physiotherapy unit, Volleyball Court, Kho-Kho Field, NSS with Four Units, NCC (two companies) with firing range, modernized College Library and some other valuable assets.



The college library has already been recently modernized with KOHA software for accessing the students online including installation of software for accessing books at home. The college website was also upgraded and developed with a new domain (*ac.in*) giving much emphasis on online teaching learning processes (LMS) since the Covid-19 pandemic situation. Besides teaching, the college has been giving due emphasis in research activities, a number of Research Projects funded by the UGC and other funding agencies are conducted by the faculties over the years. The college is successfully running Netaji Subhas Open University (NSOU), a distance learning University as study center since 2004 affiliating various UG & PG courses for both Arts and Science. The B.P.Ed course in the college is also running successfully since 2003 with

various programs organized by the students and the faculty members. The newly introduced four Post Graduate courses and BCA course are running successfully since few years. A few remarkable successes were gained by a student of PG Mathematics in higher studies and notable achievement has been made by many BCA students in campus recruitment programme of some reputed companies like Wipro, Infosys, Deloitte etc. and also in ICICI Bank and already got placement in those concerns in recent past. Keeping in view the demand of time, the college has taken special drive to revive Commerce education with Honours in Accounting & Finance.

The 'Incentive programme' which was introduced by the IQAC of the college for the students and teachers of the college for quality education and also to encourage the students and teachers for higher studies / research have been successfully executed. The faculty exchange programme has been initiated through executing 'Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)' with many colleges/Institutions/ Organizations to improve the quality of education during the running session. A few departments have organized seminar at National and international level involving the society and other organizations with some eminent speakers of international reputations. A blended mode of education has been introduced in various departments, especially in PG courses since Covid 19 period. The guardians were also met offline as well as online in various subjects during this session for sharing information about the progress of their wards and for improving Parent-Teacher relationship as well. The college fees for all the existing streams (both UG & PG) have been curtailed to a considerable extent keeping in mind the financial condition of the guardians during the last academic session. The Alumni Association of the college has been reconstructed for making relationship between the former students and the present students for their future benefit.

Ragging in the college campus is totally banned in all its departments, constitutional units, including all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc), whether public or private and anyone found guilty of ragging and /or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. ICC (Internal Complaint Cell) has been activated as per guidelines of UGC to prevent sexual harassment in the campus.

I am very much proud of my institution for having a very co-operative Governing Body, faculty members, non-teaching staff and other associated staff. The Governing Body of the college has enabled me running a fair and transparent administration and has taken many bold positive steps to improve efficiency in order to provide quality education. I am also grateful for valuable guidance from Vidyasagar University, local authorities like Garhbeta Block-I Panchayat Samity, Police Station & Garhbeta Health Centre. I am also grateful to all our patrons, well-wishers, guardians and local people for their full co-operation enabling me running the college in a smooth way. We would always look forward for constructive and valuable suggestions for paving the path of a better tomorrow and reaching towards a desired destination.

## INTRODUCTION



In the Bargiraj Dynasty, Garhbeta was a small hamlet. As found in history, this place became popular in the art and culture since the 16th century. The river Silabati was a silent spectator of many ups and downs happened in Garhbeta. There is many evidence that occurred in British Rule of oppression and its strong opposition from the people of Garhbeta. To take a frontier role in the development of the nation, the people of Garhbeta established Garhbeta High School in 1888.

It was a milestone in education. The well known leader in 'Quit India' Movement' Late Gobinda Kurnar Singha envisaged to establish one higher educational institution at Garhbeta, and he successfully did this noble work with the full support of the villagers as well as the Zamindar of this area. The auspicious day in which the 'Rarah Bangla' got the door to higher study was 13th August 1948. Garhbeta had rich cultural heritage in its past. The bank of the holy river Silabati was the mother of many great sons like freedom fighter, educationist, big corporate owner etc. The place with religious interest, enchanting sight of the Mahabharata fame 'Gangani' and the varied beauty of pleasant vast green forest and laterite soil attract many visitors with diverse interest on different occasions throughout the year. Much more water has passed through Silabati,

Garhbeta adopted various changes in the course of time. Fertile land, well connected road & railways and experts in various fields put Garhbeta to its inevitable position in agriculture, business and education. The Garhbeta College was established on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 1948 under the leadership of Late Govinda Kumar Singha. He was the founder secretary of the college. The college had started its journey from Banerjee danga High School with only 50 students and on 12th February 1950 the college was shifted to its campus constituted by the generous donation of 2.58 acres of land by the local freedom fighter Late Basanta Kumar Sarkar and 9.56 acres of land by Midnapore Zamindar Company. The college is marching forward with a vision to achieve its mission of catering to higher education for students of Paschim Medinipur and the adjoining district of Bankura and Hooghly. In the 75 years of its long journey started just with a corrugated shade in the jungle, the college has now reached significant height and possesses large buildings, well established laboratories with sophisticated instruments and provided with other basic amenities that are essential for an institution of higher learning. At the inception the College was affiliated to the University of Calcutta with Arts and Commerce stream in intermediate standard. Affiliation upto B.A. (Pass) standard was extended in 1957, followed by B.Sc. (Pass) in 1960 and Mathematics (Hons.) and History (Hons.) in 1964. Subsequently, University of Calcutta granted B. Com (Pass), Zoology (Pass) and Botany (Pass) in 1982 and 1983 respectively. In 1985, the hunger for education of the people of undivided Midnapore received the long waiting and most coveted gift from Vidyasagar University from UGC as well as Govt. of West Bengal. And Garhbeta College became affiliated to the University and the college steadily progressed in all its dimensions of academic sphere. Now the college offers honours in fourteen subjects in arts, science, and commerce along with the newly introduced Santali Hons, and four post-graduate courses in Bengali (M.A.), History (M.A.), Mathematics (M.Sc.) and Zoology (M.Sc.). Besides, there are one major vocational course (O.M.S.P.) and two professional course B.P. Ed, (N.C.T.E approved) & BCA (since 2016) also running in the college. These are remarkable achievement of Garhbeta College, and these will offer higher studies to the students of this locality at their doorstep. There has been continuous research activity in most of the departments as well. Ex-students are also in constant touch with the departments in the perspective of higher studies and research. To send the message that the education is not only for all but for all ages, Garhbeta College has a wing of distance education in its campus namely Netaji Subhas Open University Study Centre. Soon Garhbeta College will take a frontier leadership in the propagation of higher education in the Country

**Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):** These are generic courses aimed to enhance skills in communication and local languages. Four (04) SEC courses shall be of 2 credits each distributed in first four semesters.

**Skills Enhancement Courses (SEC):** These courses are aimed at imparting practical skills, hands-on training, soft skills, etc., to enhance the employability of students. Three (03) SEC courses shall be of 3 credits each. Colleges shall arrange the skill training to the students in association with Sector Skill Councils (SSC)/ Paschim Banga Society for Skill Development (PBSSD) or any other recognized council/organizations. Separate list of courses under SEC may be provided in due course. Training, assignment evaluation etc. shall be conducted at the College level. SEC courses may also be taken from the SWAYAM/ MOOC/NSQF platform as per

applicability. College authority may designate course coordinator for SEC for each discipline who may guide students to complete the courses.

**Value-Added Courses(VAC):** Two (02) introductory-level Value added courses are to enhance the standard of the students beyond specified academic curriculum. Courses shall be of 2 credits each.

**Two (02) VAC to be selected from below:**

**For Semester-I** (01 paper-fixed)

- a. Environmental Studies (common for all programs)

**For Semester-II** (01 paper to be selected)

- b. Human Rights
- c. Yoga and Wellness
- d. Disaster Management

**Summer Internship/Apprenticeship/Community Services:** Students will be provided with opportunities for Internship/Apprenticeship/Community Services with nearby locality, local bodies, local industry, business organizations, health and allied areas. It shall be a short-term engagement of 8 weeks in a suitable organization or hands on training in order to gain work experience.

**There shall be two forms of summer Training:**

- i) **Community Services (4 Credits):** In the 1st year of study, students shall be oriented to 4- Credits Community Services course. *Minimum 120 hours of engagement in NSS, Rural Development and Social Development activities in association with local governments (such as panchayats, municipalities etc.)* under the supervision of a college faculty designated as Course Coordinator for Community Services. For the Community Services course, student shall be evaluated at the end of 2nd Semester by the concerned authorities following the *Point Scale Activity Chart* given in **Annexure-4**.
- ii) **Internship/ Apprenticeship/ Entrepreneurship: (4 Credits):** In the 2nd year of study during 4th Semester, students shall be oriented to 4-Credits Internship/ Apprenticeship/ Entrepreneurship. *Minimum of 120 hours training/internship/apprenticeship in localbodies, local industry, NGOs, business organizations, health and allied areas, ruralentrepreneurs, survey, media organizations, artists, crafts persons etc.* shall be under thesupervision of a college faculty designated as Internship/apprenticeship/entrepreneurshipCoordinator. Students of Internship/ Apprenticeship shall have to produce a report relatedto the work carried out along with the Certificate of completion from the concernedauthority. Student shall be evaluated by the University nominated External Examiner(s)based on the report and subsequent viva-voce. The colleges shall establish Internship/Apprenticeship/ Entrepreneurship Cell to maintaining liaison with industry/ bodies/institution to facilitate the students.

**RESEARCH PROJECT/DISSERTATION:** Students choosing a 4-Year Bachelor's degree(**Honours with Research**) are required to take up research projects under the guidance of the assigned faculty member of College/ University. The students are expected to complete the **Research Project in the 4th Year of study**. The research outcome of their project work is to be presented during evaluation and furthermore may be published in journals or presented in conferences etc. As per the policy guidelines of CCFUP, the required facilities for a college to offer Bachelor's degree (Honours with Research) are – Library facility, access to journals, computer lab, laboratory, infrastructure for research work and two faculty members

recognized as PhD supervisions. *Colleges willing to offer Honours with Research programme may apply to the concerned University Authorities for their concurrence.*

**ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDIT (ABC):**The Academic Bank of Credit, a national-level facility, is a prime attribute in NEP for imparting flexibility to the curriculum framework and interdisciplinary/ multidisciplinary academic mobility of students across the higher education institutions (HEIs) in the country with an appropriate “credit transfer” mechanism. It is a mechanism to facilitate the students to choose their own learning path to attain a degree/diploma/certificate, working on the principle of multiple entry and exit as well as anytime, anywhere, and any level of learning. The multiple entries and exit options through ABC for students are facilitated at the undergraduate levels. It would facilitate credit accumulation through the facility created by the ABC scheme in the “*Academic Bank Account*” opened for students across the country to transfer and consolidate their credits by undergoing courses in any eligible Higher Education Institutes (HEIs). *Vidyasagar University offering multiple entries and exit system is registered in the ABC platform to enable credit transfer” and credit acceptance.* The ABC allows for credit redemption by commuting the accrued credits in the Academic Bank Account maintained in the ABC to fulfill the credits requirements for awarding certificate/diploma/degree by the University. 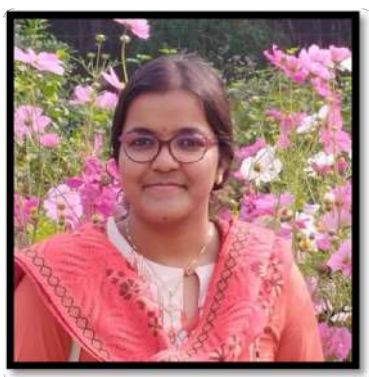

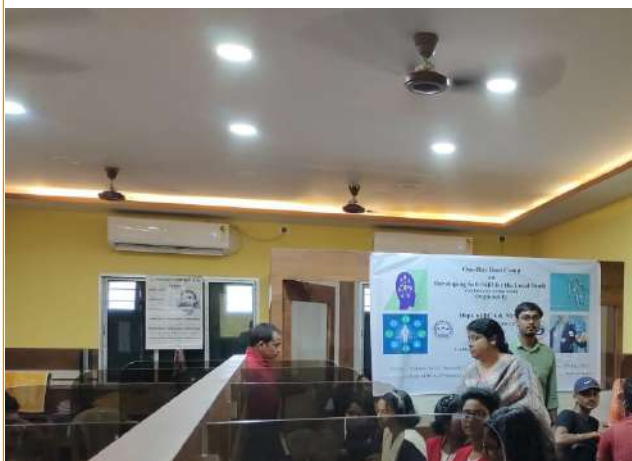
## FOREST WEEK OBSERVATION\_19/07/2023

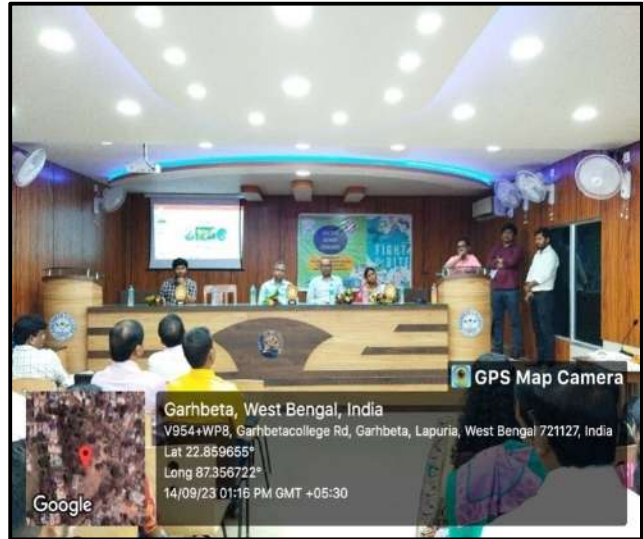
The NSS Units of Garhbeta College actively participated in

## “MANAGING WASTE FOR A BETTER FUTURE”



The Nature and Environment subcommittee of Garhbeta College, in association with the NSS Units, and NCC – 53rd Bengal Battalion of the college, has organized a seminar on waste management on 10th October, 2023. It was to raise awareness and learn more about waste management. The seminar was

titled, “Managing Waste for A Better Future”. The event took place in collaboration with Garhbeta Gram Panchayat. Prof. Debarati Kundu from the nationally renowned organization Garbage Free India was the invited speaker at the seminar. It was inaugurated by the honourable principal of the college Dr. Hariprasad Sarkar. In the beginning, Dr. Sarkar emphasised the main target of the seminar, which was to spread awareness about the urgency of learning to manage wastes in an environmentally conscious way. It is of utmost importance to understand the significance, impact and our responsibilities of and about environmental degradation. The speaker, Ms Kundu explained various aspects of the degrading environment and the role of wastes that we generate regularly, which particularly affects all the living organisms on this planet earth. Ms Kundu delivered her talk primarily in vernacular language. Different known and unknown impacts of the dumping of untreated wastes on the environment was discussed very lucidly. The role of mismanagement of wastes in affecting the environment negatively, the impact of environmental degradation on the ways of lives in turn, creates a situation that is gradually slipping out of our control and is increasingly becoming hard to break. Prof. Kundu stressed upon the responsibility of all of us to identify, deal and mitigate our own impact on the environment, if we are serious about the degradation of it. She also demonstrated the ways in which the stakeholders of an academic institution can make a difference through properly performing their role in managing the wastes generated in and by the institution. A long and very much in-depth discussion followed the main talk, during the question-and answer session. 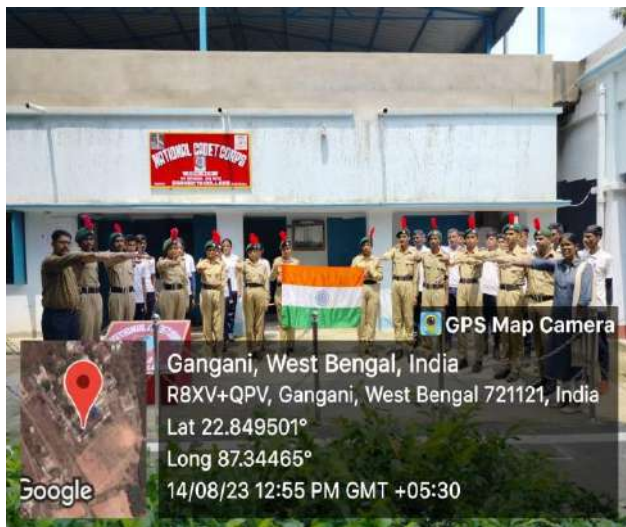
